1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate, the House of Representatives
2 concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 1994
3 regular session of the Fifty-third Legislature:

4 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all
5 House bills not in conference, House joint resolutions, House
6 concurrent resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession
7 that have not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House
8 of Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House
9 Rules Committee for third reading; and

10 (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all
11 Senate bills not in conference, Senate joint resolutions, Senate
12 concurrent resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession
13 that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon
14 receipt by the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the
15 Senate Rules Committee for third reading; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the
17 Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their
18 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE
19 of the 1994 regular session of the Fifty-third Legislature, all
20 legislative measures including all bills, opposite house bills in
21 conference, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint

1 memorials that may at that time be in their respective houses and all
2 records, journals, dockets, and other documents pertaining thereto; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That retention of opposite house bills in
4 conference does not remove the legal requirement that bills pass both
5 houses during the same legislative session; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special
7 session of the Fifty-third Legislature shall be numbered as a
8 continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the 1994 regular
9 session of the Fifty-third Legislature.
