- BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring, That immediately before adjournment SINE DIE of this 1994 regular session of the Fifty-third Legislature:
- 4 (1) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all 5 House bills not in conference, House joint resolutions, House 6 concurrent resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession 7 that have not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House 8 of Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House 9 Rules Committee for third reading; and
- (2) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all Senate bills not in conference, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions, and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third reading; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 1994 regular session of the Fifty-third Legislature, all legislative measures including all bills, opposite house bills in conference, joint resolutions, concurrent resolutions, and joint

memorials that may at that time be in their respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other documents pertaining thereto; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That retention of opposite house bills in conference does not remove the legal requirement that bills pass both houses during the same legislative session; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any special session of the Fifty-third Legislature shall be numbered as a
