- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature supports the establishment
- 6 of minimum standards for intercollegiate coaches and a process to
- 7 ensure the safety and appropriate skill development of student
- 8 athletes.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The state board for community and technical
- 10 colleges in consultation with the Northwest athletic association of
- 11 community colleges and other interested parties shall encourage
- 12 community colleges to ensure that intercollegiate coaches meet the
- 13 following minimum standards:
- 14 (1) Verification of up-to-date certification in first aid and
- 15 cardiopulmonary resuscitation;
- 16 (2) Maintaining knowledge of Northwest athletic association of
- 17 community colleges codes, rules, and institutional policy; and

- 1 (3) Encouragement of coaches to participate in appropriate in-2 service training and activities.
- 3 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The community and technical colleges are encouraged to provide training to promote development of coaching 4 competence and to enhance the coaching techniques of intercollegiate 5 The community and technical colleges may offer this 6 coaches. 7 educational service to coaches in the community and technical colleges, common schools, amateur teams, youth groups, and community sports 8 The community and technical colleges may provide this 9 educational service through curriculum courses, workshops, or in-10 11 service training.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The state board for community and technical colleges shall report to the legislature by December 30, 1994, on the status of this act. The report shall include, but not be limited to:
- 15 (1) An evaluation of the current process for determining the 16 qualifications of community college intercollegiate coaches; and
- 17 (2) A recommendation of methods for improving the knowledge and 18 competence of intercollegiate coaches.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. Sections 2 and 3 of this act are each added to chapter 28B.50 RCW.
