1 AN ACT Relating to estimating charges for carrying household goods;
2 adding a new section to chapter 81.80 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 81.80 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 When a common carrier gives an estimate of charges for services in
7 carrying household goods, the carrier will endeavor to accurately
8 reflect the actual charges. The carrier is subject to a monetary
9 penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars per violation when the
10 actual charges exceed the percentages allowed by the commission.
