1            AN ACT Relating to warrants redeemed by the state treasurer; and  
2 amending RCW 43.08.061.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.08.061 and 1981 c 10 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            The public printer shall print all state treasury warrants for  
7 distribution as directed by the state treasurer. All warrants redeemed  
8 by the state treasurer shall be retained for a period of (~~two years~~)  
9 one year, following their redemption, after which they may be destroyed  
10 without regard to the requirements imposed for their destruction by  
11 chapter 40.14 RCW.
