- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.43 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Whenever real property owned by the state of Washington and under
- 8 the jurisdiction of the Washington state patrol is no longer required,
- 9 it may be sold at fair market value. All proceeds received from the
- 10 sale of real property, less any real estate broker commissions, shall
- 11 be deposited into the state patrol highway account: PROVIDED, That if
- 12 accounts or funds other than the state patrol highway account have
- 13 contributed to the purchase or improvement of the real property, the
- 14 office of financial management shall determine the proportional equity
- 15 of each account or fund in the property and improvements, and shall
- 16 direct the proceeds to be deposited proportionally therein.
