- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.12 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The department of natural resources shall determine the fair market
- 8 rental rate for leases to nonprofit television reception improvement
- 9 districts. It is the intent of the legislature to appropriate general
- 10 funds to pay a portion of the rent charged to nonprofit television
- 11 reception improvement districts. It is the further intent of the
- 12 legislature that such a lessee pay an annual lease rent of fifty
- 13 percent of the fair market rental rate, as long as there is a general
- 14 fund appropriation to compensate the trusts for the remainder of the
- 15 fair market rental rate.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
- 17 act referencing this act by bill number is not provided by June 30,
- 18 1994, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1994.
