1            AN ACT Relating to the rental of public lands; adding a new section  
2 to chapter 79.12 RCW; creating a new section; and providing an  
3 effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.12 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7            The department of natural resources shall determine the fair market  
8 rental rate for leases to nonprofit television reception improvement  
9 districts. It is the intent of the legislature to appropriate general  
10 funds to pay a portion of the rent charged to nonprofit television  
11 reception improvement districts. It is the further intent of the  
12 legislature that such a lessee pay an annual lease rent of fifty  
13 percent of the fair market rental rate, as long as there is a general  
14 fund appropriation to compensate the trusts for the remainder of the  
15 fair market rental rate.

16            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this  
17 act referencing this act by bill number is not provided by June 30,  
18 1994, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void.

1        NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 3.**    This act shall take effect July 1, 1994.
