4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.34.080 and 1991 c 363 s 68 and 1991 c 245 s 10 are
6 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

7 All sales of county property ordered after a public hearing upon
8 the proposal to dispose thereof must be supervised by the county
9 treasurer and may be sold at a county or other government agency's
10 public auction, at a privately operated consignment auction that is
11 open to the public, or by sealed bid to the highest and best bidder
12 (~~over~~) meeting or exceeding the minimum sale price as directed by the
13 county legislative authority.
