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**SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1325**

1            AN ACT Relating to giving local governments the option to acquire  
2 services or goods under purchasing arrangements made by state agencies;  
3 and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**    The department, in consultation with  
6 associations of local governments, shall develop a proposal to offer  
7 contracts for air service fares to local government employees at the  
8 best available rates. In developing the proposal, the elements to be  
9 considered include, but are not limited to:

10            (1) Guidelines for predicting and reporting the volume, frequency,  
11 and destinations of air travel requirements of local government  
12 employees;

13            (2) A cost-effective system for aggregating bookings, accounting,  
14 and payments for local employee air travel;

15            (3) The most appropriate means for preparing invitations to bid,  
16 that will offer the greatest possible opportunity for local governments  
17 to take advantage of bulk rates in a manner that will avoid delay in  
18 putting the contracts into place;

1 (4) Establishment of an ongoing clearinghouse of favorable rates,  
2 schedules, and destinations that can be made readily available to local  
3 government managers in planning air travel for their employees; and  
4 (5) Any other services that will assist local governments in  
5 planning air travel on essential public business.

6 The results of the consultation and progress on the proposal shall  
7 be reported to the senate committee on government operations and the  
8 house of representatives committee on local government by December 15,  
9 1993.
