4 Sec. 1. RCW 49.46.020 and 1989 c 1 s 2 are each amended to read as 5 follows:

6 (1) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees who 7 has reached the age of eighteen years wages at a rate of not less than 8 ((three dollars and eighty-five cents per hour except as may be 9 otherwise provided under this section. Beginning January 1, 1990, the 10 state minimum wage shall be)) four dollars and ((twenty-five)) ninety 11 cents per hour.

(2) The director shall by regulation establish the minimum wage for
employees under the age of eighteen years.
