- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that Central
- 6 Washington University, Eastern Washington University, Western
- 7 Washington University, and The Evergreen State College are the state's
- 8 comprehensive undergraduate institutions and each should share equally
- 9 in the benefits derived from lands set apart in the enabling act for
- 10 state normal school purposes.
- 11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.35.751 and 1991 sp.s. c 13 s 95 are each amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 All moneys received from the lease or rental of lands set apart by
- 14 the enabling act for state normal schools purposes; all interest or
- 15 income arising from the proceeds of the sale of such lands or of the
- 16 timber, fallen timber, stone, gravel, or other valuable material
- 17 thereon, less the allocation to the state treasurer's service ((account
- 18 (fund))) fund pursuant to RCW 43.08.190 and the state investment board

expense account pursuant to RCW 43.33A.160; and all moneys received as 1 interest on deferred payments on contracts for the sale of such lands, 2 shall from time to time be paid into the state treasury and credited to 3 4 the Eastern Washington University, Central Washington University, 5 Western Washington University and The Evergreen State College capital projects accounts as herein provided to be expended for capital 6 7 projects, and bond retirement purposes as set forth in RCW 28B.35.750, 8 as now or hereafter amended. Eastern Washington University, Central 9 Washington University, Western Washington University, and The Evergreen 10 State College shall be credited with one-fourth of the total amount((÷ PROVIDED, That Eastern Washington University, Central Washington 11 12 University and Western Washington University shall each be credited 13 with one-third of the total amount for so long as there remain unpaid and outstanding any bonds which are payable in whole or in part out of 14 15 the moneys, interest or income described in this section)) beginning July 1, 2003. Beginning July 1, 1995, The Evergreen State College 16 shall receive five percent of the total amount not obligated to 17 repayment of bonds; Eastern Washington University, Central Washington 18 19 University, and Western Washington University shall receive equal amounts of the remaining amount. Beginning July 1, 1997, The Evergreen 20 State College shall receive ten percent of the total amount not 21 obligated to repayment of bonds; Eastern Washington University, Central 22 23 Washington University, and Western Washington University shall receive 24 equal amounts of the remaining amount. Beginning July 1, 1999, The 25 Evergreen State College shall receive fifteen percent of the total amount not dedicated to repayment of bonds; Eastern Washington 26 University, Central Washington University, and Western Washington 27 University shall each receive equal amounts of the remaining amount. 28 Beginning July 1, 2001, The Evergreen State College shall receive 29 30 twenty percent of the total amount not obligated to repayment of bonds; 31 Eastern Washington University, Central Washington University, and Western Washington University shall each receive equal amounts of the 32 remaining amount. 33

34 **Sec. 3.** RCW 43.79.150 and 1977 ex.s. c 169 s 104 are each amended 35 to read as follows:

The one hundred thousand acres of land granted by the United States government to the state for state normal schools in section 17 of the enabling act are assigned to the support of the regional universities,

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- 1 which were formerly the state colleges of education and to The
- 2 Evergreen State College.
