- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.08.064 and 1992 c 189 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 There shall be in the counties of Benton and Franklin jointly, five
- 7 judges of the superior court; in the county of Clallam, two judges of
- 8 the superior court; in the county of Jefferson, one judge of the
- 9 superior court; in the county of Snohomish, thirteen judges of the
- 10 superior court; in the counties of Asotin, Columbia and Garfield
- 11 jointly, one judge of the superior court; in the county of Cowlitz,

- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The additional judicial position created by
- 15 section 1 of this act shall be effective only if Cowlitz county through
- 16 its duly constituted legislative authority documents its approval of
- 17 the additional position and its agreement that it will pay out of

- 1 county funds, without reimbursement from the state, the expenses of the
- 2 additional judicial position as provided by statute.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
- 4 act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 30,
- 5 1993, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and
- 6 void.
