1 AN ACT Relating to superior courts; amending RCW 2.08.064; and
2 creating new sections.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.08.064 and 1992 c 189 s 4 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 There shall be in the counties of Benton and Franklin jointly, five
7 judges of the superior court; in the county of Clallam, two judges of
8 the superior court; in the county of Jefferson, one judge of the
9 superior court; in the county of Snohomish, thirteen judges of the
10 superior court; in the counties of Asotin, Columbia and Garfield
11 jointly, one judge of the superior court; in the county of Cowlitz,
12 ((three)) four judges of the superior court; in the counties of
13 Klickitat and Skamania jointly, one judge of the superior court.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The additional judicial position created by
15 section 1 of this act shall be effective only if Cowlitz county through
16 its duly constituted legislative authority documents its approval of
17 the additional position and its agreement that it will pay out of

1 county funds, without reimbursement from the state, the expenses of the
2 additional judicial position as provided by statute.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
4 act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 30,
5 1993, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act shall be null and
6 void.
