Brief Description: Providing for notification to crime victims of certain rights.

HB 1160-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/16/93)

Requires a written statement of the rights of crime victims to be provided at the time a crime is reported to law enforcement officials.

Provides for a crime victim advocate to be present at investigative interviews whenever practical.

Limits the role of the advocate to provide emotional support to the victim.
