## HB 1372-S.E - DIGEST

## (DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Requires each state agency to define its mission, establish measurable goals, and develop measurable outcome-based objectives.

Revises the responsibility of the office of financial development and the legislative budget committee to evaluate the agencies' performance.

Expands the authority of the state auditor for performance audits.

Provides that the act shall be null and void if appropriations are not approved.
