Brief Description: Exempting juvenile newspaper carriers from business and occupation tax.

HB 2080-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/9/94)

Exempts newspaper carriers under the age of eighteen from the business and occupation tax.

Prohibits cities and towns from licensing the carriers for regulatory or revenue-generating purposes.

Requires the employer to notify the carrier that the exemption will expire at age eighteen.
