Brief Description: Requiring that victims of felony sex offenses be given notice of HIV test results, whether the results are positive or negative.

HB 2151-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Requires the disclosure of test results under RCW 70.24.105 if the results are negative or positive.

Requires notification of the right of disclosure to be followed by appropriate counseling.
