## HB 2333 - DIGEST

## (DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that a parent of a child is guilty of custodial interference in the first degree if the parent takes the child with the intent to deny access to the other parent having the lawful right to time with the child pursuant to a court-ordered parenting plan.

Provides a class C felony offense for violations.
