HB 2463-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Establishes conditions of parole to submit to drug and alcohol testing and to refrain from associations with individuals with criminal histories.

Requires the juvenile to submit to searches by law enforcement personnel.

Provides for an initial intensive monitoring period followed by a home detention period.
