HB 2605-S2.E - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Authorizes domestic student exchange programs between state institutions and out-of-state institutions which would allow students to pay resident tuition rates.

Revises the Washington Scholars Program to honor three graduating seniors in each legislative district.

Authorizes the transfer of money for exceptional faculty awards from the local endowment fund to its foundation's local endowment fund.

Creates the national guard conditional scholarship program and requires recipients to serve one year in the guard for each year of scholarship benefits.
