SB 5225-S - DIGEST

Provides for the solicitation and approval of applications from local educational organizations to develop and implement work-based learning programs for youth.

Establishes standards for programs to receive grants.

Directs the commission on student learning to establish statewide competency standards to assess student progress.

Requires reports on the program on December 15th of each odd-numbered year.

Makes an appropriation of two hundred thousand dollars to carry out the purposes of the act.
