7 "**Sec. 2.** RCW 70.94.750 and 1991 c 199 s 412 are each amended
8 to read as follows:

9 The following outdoor fires described in this section may be
10 burned subject to the provisions of this chapter and also subject
11 to city ordinances, county resolutions, rules of fire districts and
12 laws, and rules enforced by the department of natural resources if
13 a permit has been issued by a fire protection agency, county, or
14 conservation district:

15 (1) Fires consisting of leaves, clippings, prunings and other
16 yard and gardening refuse, and fires consisting of paper,
17 cardboard, and other paper products originating on lands
18 immediately adjacent and in close proximity to a human dwelling and
19 burned on such lands by the property owner or his or her designee.

20 (2) Fires consisting of residue of a natural character such as
21 trees, stumps, shrubbery or other natural vegetation arising from
22 land clearing projects or agricultural pursuits for pest or disease
23 control; provided the fires described in this subsection may be
24 prohibited in those areas having a general population density of
25 one thousand or more persons per square mile."

27 Renumber remaining sections consecutively and correct any
28 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Allows paper and paper products to be burned, subject
to local ordinances, resolutions, or laws.
