- 6 "Sec. 2. RCW 70.94.141 and 1991 c 199 s 706 are each amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 The board of any activated authority in addition to any other 9 powers vested in them by law, shall have power to:
- 10 (1) Adopt, amend, and repeal its own rules and regulations, implementing this chapter and consistent with, and with regard to 11 12 agricultural burning no more stringent than it, after consideration at 13 a public hearing held in accordance with chapter 42.30 RCW. Rules and 14 regulations shall also be adopted in accordance with the notice and adoption procedures set forth in RCW 34.05.320, those provisions of RCW 15 16 34.05.325 that are not in conflict with chapter 42.30 RCW, and with the 17 procedures of RCW 34.05.340, 34.05.355 through 34.05.380, and with chapter 34.08 RCW, except that rules shall not be published in the 18 Washington Administrative Code. Judicial review of rules adopted by an 19 20 authority shall be in accordance with Part V of chapter 34.05 RCW. An 21 air pollution control authority shall not be deemed to be a state 22 agency.
- 23 (2) Hold hearings relating to any aspect of or matter in the 24 administration of this chapter not prohibited by the provisions of 25 chapter 62, Laws of 1970 ex. sess. and in connection therewith issue 26 subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of 27 evidence, administer oaths, and take the testimony of any person under 28 oath.
- 29 (3) Issue such orders as may be necessary to effectuate the 30 purposes of this chapter and enforce the same by all appropriate 31 administrative and judicial proceedings subject to the rights of appeal 32 as provided in chapter 62, Laws of 1970 ex. sess.
- 33 (4) Require access to records, books, files, and other information 34 specific to the control, recovery, or release of air contaminants into 35 the atmosphere.
- 36 (5) Secure necessary scientific, technical, administrative, and

- operational services, including laboratory facilities, by contract or otherwise.
- 3 (6) Prepare and develop a comprehensive plan or plans for the 4 prevention, abatement, and control of air pollution within its 5 jurisdiction.
- 6 (7) Encourage voluntary cooperation by persons or affected groups 7 to achieve the purposes of this chapter.
- 8 (8) Encourage and conduct studies, investigation, and research 9 relating to air pollution and its causes, effects, prevention, 10 abatement, and control.
- 11 (9) Collect and disseminate information and conduct educational and 12 training programs relating to air pollution.
- (10) Advise, consult, cooperate, and contract with agencies and departments and the educational institutions of the state, other political subdivisions, industries, other states, interstate or interlocal agencies, and the United States government, and with interested persons or groups.
- (11) Consult, upon request, with any person proposing to construct, 18 19 install, or otherwise acquire an air contaminant source or device or 20 system for the control thereof, concerning the efficacy of such device or system, or the air pollution problems which may be related to the 21 source, device, or system. Nothing in any such consultation shall be 22 23 construed to relieve any person from compliance with this chapter, ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations in force pursuant 24 25 thereto, or any other provision of law.
- (12) Accept, receive, disburse, and administer grants or other funds or gifts from any source, including public and private agencies and the United States government for the purpose of carrying out any of the functions of this chapter."
