6 On page 1, after line 11, insert the following:

7 "(4) As used in this section and RCW 66.44.200, "apparently under
8 the influence of liquor" may be determined by observing a combination
9 of, but not limited to, the following conditions displayed by an
10 individual:

11 (a) Being overly friendly;

12 (b) Bragging;

13 (c) Talking loudly;

14 (d) Sudden or unexplained mood changes;

15 (e) Annoying other customers;

16 (f) Complaining about strength of drink or slow service;

17 (g) Consuming drinks faster than usual; gulping drinks; ordering
18 doubles;

19 (h) Arguing with employees or other customers;

20 (i) Using foul language;

21 (j) Sullen, uncommunicative except to order drinks;

22 (k) Buying rounds for strangers or the house;

23 (l) Lighting more than one cigarette at a time;

24 (m) Inability to light cigarette;

25 (n) Glassy eyes, dilated pupils, lack of focus;

26 (o) Loss of train of thought (stops talking in mid-sentence);

27 (p) Slurred speech or speaking very slowly and deliberately;

28 (q) Inability to pick up money or dropping money; inability to
29 count out correct amount for drink;

30 (r) Spilling drink; missing mouth with glass;

31 (s) Head bobbing, eyelids drooping, looking sleepy; and

32 (t) Staggering, swaying while standing still; holding on to bar or
33 chair."
