8 **Sec. 101.** RCW 74.12.420 and 1994 c 299 s 9 are each amended to 9 read as follows:

The legislature recognizes that long-term recipients of aid to 10 11 families with dependent children may require a period of several years 12 to attain economic self-sufficiency. To provide incentives for long-13 term recipients to leave public assistance and accept paid employment, the legislature finds that less punitive and onerous sanctions than 14 15 those required by the federal government are appropriate. 16 legislature finds that a ten percent reduction in grants for long-term recipients that may be replaced through earned income is a more 17 18 positive approach than sanctions required by the federal government for 19 long-term recipients who fail to comply with requirements of the job 20 opportunities and basic skills program. A long-term recipient shall 21 not be subject to two simultaneous sanctions for failure to comply with 22 the participation requirements of the job opportunities and basic 23 skills program and for exceeding the length of stay provisions of this

- 25 (1) After ((forty-eight)) twenty-four monthly benefit payments in 26 ((a)) the preceding sixty-month period, and after each of three additional twelve monthly benefit payments, the aid to families with 27 dependent children monthly benefit payment shall be reduced by ten 28 percent of the payment standard((, except that)). After seventy-two 29 30 full or partial monthly benefit payments, a recipient is ineligible for monthly benefit payments for two years. After ((forty-eight)) thirty-31 \underline{six} monthly payments in ((a)) the preceding sixty-month period, full 32 33 monthly benefit payments may be made if:
- 34 (a) The person is incapacitated or is needed in the home to care 35 for a member of the household who is incapacitated;

- 12 <u>(f) Child care is not made available by the department; or</u>
- 13 <u>(g) The person was not offered services by the job opportunities</u> 14 <u>and basic skills program at least six months before the benefit</u> 15 <u>reduction</u>.
- (2) ((For purposes of determining the amount of the food stamp benefit for recipients subject to benefit reductions provided for in subsection (1) of this section, countable income from the aid to families with dependent children program shall be set at the payment standard.
- (3)) For purposes of determining monthly benefit payments for twoparent aid to families with dependent children households, the length of stay criterion will be applied to the parent with the longer history of public assistance receipt.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 102.** A new section is added to chapter 74.12 RCW to read as follows:
- A recipient's length of stay shall be determined based on actual months of receipt of public assistance, including months of receipt of public assistance before the effective date of this section. Benefits shall not be reduced under this section before July 1, 1996.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 103. A new section is added to chapter 74.12 RCW to read as follows:
- A family receiving or applying for assistance under the aid to families with dependent children program shall enter into a contract satisfying the requirements of this section. The contract shall be entered into by the department of social and health services and the recipient on a form prescribed by the department. The contract shall

- 1 include a list of available benefits to which the family is eligible,
- 2 a summary of the responsibilities the recipient must accept, and
- 3 related conditions of benefits, including time limits and benefit

5 PART II - REQUIRING MANDATORY PARTICIPATION 6 IN THE JOB OPPORTUNITIES AND BASIC SKILLS PROGRAM

7 **Sec. 201.** RCW 74.25.020 and 1993 c 312 s 7 are each amended to 8 read as follows:

- 9 (1) The department of social and health services is authorized to contract with public and private employment and training agencies and 10 11 other public service entities to provide services prescribed or allowed 12 under the federal social security act, as amended, to carry out the 13 purposes of the jobs training program. The department of social and health services has sole authority and responsibility to carry out the 14 job opportunities and basic skills training program. No contracting 15 entity shall have the authority to review, change, or disapprove any 16 17 administrative decision, or otherwise substitute its judgment for that 18 of the department of social and health services as to the application of policies and rules adopted by the department of social and health 19 20 services.
 - (2) ((To the extent feasible under federal law, the department of social and health services and all entities contracting with it shall give first priority of service to individuals volunteering for program participation)) The department of social and health services shall develop a realistic schedule for the phase-in of client participation in the job opportunities and basic skills training program based on the availability of state and federal funding.
 - (3) The department of social and health services shall adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW ((establishing)) that conform to the criteria in federal law for mandatory program participation as well as establish criteria constituting circumstances of good cause for an individual failing or refusing to participate in an assigned program component, or failing or refusing to accept or retain employment. ((These)) The good cause criteria shall include, but not be limited to, the following circumstances: (a) If the individual is a parent or other relative personally providing care for a child under age ((six)) three years, and the employment would require the individual to work more than

- 1 twenty hours per week; (b) if child care, or day care for an
- 2 incapacitated individual living in the same home as a dependent child,
- 3 is necessary for an individual to participate or continue participation
- 4 in the program or accept employment, and such care is not available,
- 5 and the department of social and health services fails to provide such
- 6 care; (c) the employment would result in the family of the participant
- 7 experiencing a net loss of cash income; or (d) circumstances that are
- 8 beyond the control of the individual's household, either on a short-
- 9 term or on an ongoing basis.
- 10 $((\frac{4}{1}))$ (3) The department of social and health services shall
- 11 adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW as necessary to effectuate the
- 12 intent and purpose of this chapter.

13 PART III - MISCELLANEOUS

- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 301.** A new section is added to chapter 74.12
- 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 The provision that recipients of aid to families with dependent
- 17 children may earn and keep the first thirty dollars and one-third of

- 19 payment reduced by that amount may be extended up to a twelve-month

- 26 interested parties to determine the noncustodial parent's identity.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 303.** A new section is added to chapter 74.04
- 28 RCW to read as follows:
- 29 The department shall reduce the fraudulent receipt of public
- 30 assistance through the implementation of an electronic benefit transfer
- 31 system for all public assistance programs. The department shall also
- 32 establish new verification requirements and fraud deterrence and
- 33 detection systems for all public assistance programs.
- 34 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 304.** Any savings resulting from the provisions

- 1 of this act during the 1995-97 biennium shall be used to provide
- 2 employment child care subsidies for low-income working families who
- 3 have never received public assistance from the state of Washington
- 4 under Title 74 RCW.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 305.** Part headings as used in this act do not
- 6 constitute any part of the law.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 306. If any part of this act is found to be in
- 8 conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to
- 9 the allocation of federal funds to the state, the conflicting part of
- 10 this act is inoperative solely to the extent of the conflict and with
- 11 respect to the agencies directly affected, and this finding does not
- 12 affect the operation of the remainder of this act in its application to
- 13 the agencies concerned. The rules under this act shall meet federal
- 14 requirements that are a necessary condition to the receipt of federal
- 15 funds by the state.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 307.** If any provision of this act or its
- 17 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 18 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 19 persons or circumstances is not affected."
