The superintendent of public instruction shall disseminate information about procedures for the establishment, funding, and operation of charter schools, and shall provide technical assistance to charter school applicants in the preparation of applications, to school district boards of directors in considering applications, and to charter school governing boards in matters related to the educational program, management, and financial operation of the charter school."
