- 27 (2) The assumption by any city or town of all or part of the 28 assets, facilities, or indebtedness of a special purpose district which 29 lies partially within such city or town; or
- 30 (3) The establishment of or change in the boundaries of a mutual 31 water and sewer system or separate sewer system by a water district 32 pursuant to RCW 57.08.065 or chapter 57.40 RCW, as now or hereafter 33 amended; or
- 34 (4) The establishment of or change in the boundaries of a mutual 35 sewer and water system or separate water system by a sewer district 36 pursuant to RCW 56.20.015 or chapter 56.36 RCW, as now or hereafter

- 2 (5) The extension of permanent water or sewer service outside of
- 3 its existing ((corporate boundaries)) service area by a city, town, or
- 4 special purpose district. The service area of a city, town, or special

- 25 extension is outside of the service area of the city, town, or special
- 26 district.
