5 On page 42, after line 29, strike all of section 37

6 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct internal  
7 references accordingly, and correct the title.

8 EFFECT: The provision is stricken that allows counties to create  
9 review boards to evaluate the qualifications of treatment programs for  
10 batterers that are currently subject to the department of social and  
11 health services rules and approval.

15 On page 44, after line 24, insert the following:

16 "**Sec. 38.** RCW 36.18.010 and 1991 c 26 s 2 are each amended to read  
17 as follows:

18 County auditors or recording officers shall collect the following  
19 fees for their official services:

20 For recording instruments, for the first page, legal size (eight  
21 and one-half by fourteen inches or less), five dollars; for each  
22 additional legal size page, one dollar; the fee for recording multiple  
23 transactions contained in one instrument will be calculated  
24 individually for each transaction requiring separate indexing as  
25 required under RCW 65.04.050;

26 For preparing and certifying copies, for the first legal size page,  
27 three dollars; for each additional legal size page, one dollar;

28 For preparing noncertified copies, for each legal size page, one  
29 dollar;

30 For administering an oath or taking an affidavit, with or without  
31 seal, two dollars;

1 For issuing a marriage license, eight dollars, (this fee includes  
2 taking necessary affidavits, filing returns, indexing, and transmittal  
3 of a record of the marriage to the state registrar of vital statistics)  
4 plus an additional five-dollar fee for use and support of the  
5 prevention of child abuse and neglect activities to be transmitted  
6 monthly to the state treasurer and deposited in the state general  
7 fund(~~(, which five-dollar fee shall expire June 30, 1995,)~~) plus an  
8 additional ten-dollar fee to be transmitted monthly to the state  
9 treasurer and deposited in the state general fund. The legislature  
10 intends to appropriate an amount at least equal to the revenue  
11 generated by this fee for the purposes of the displaced homemaker act,  
12 chapter 28B.04 RCW;

13 For searching records per hour, eight dollars;

14 For recording plats, fifty cents for each lot except cemetery plats  
15 for which the charge shall be twenty-five cents per lot; also one  
16 dollar for each acknowledgment, dedication, and description: PROVIDED,  
17 That there shall be a minimum fee of twenty-five dollars per plat;

18 For recording of miscellaneous records, not listed above, for first  
19 legal size page, five dollars; for each additional legal size page, one  
20 dollar;

21 For modernization and improvement of the recording and indexing  
22 system, a surcharge as provided in RCW 36.22.170."

23 Renumber the remaining section consecutively.

24 On page 44, after line 28, insert the following:

25 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 39.** Section 38 of this act is necessary for  
26 the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or  
27 support of the state government and its existing public institutions,  
28 and shall take effect immediately.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 40.** If any provision of this act or its  
30 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the  
31 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other  
32 persons or circumstances is not affected."

6 On page 1, line 9 of the title, after "section;" strike "and" and  
7 after "penalties" insert "; and declaring an emergency"

8 EFFECT: Provides statutory authority necessary to be consistent  
9 with all executive and legislative branch budget proposals extending  
10 child abuse and neglect prevention.
