5 On page 4, after line 13 of the amendment, insert the following:

6 "(3) Reclaimed water that does not meet the ground water recharge  
7 criteria may be beneficially used for surface spreading where the  
8 department of ecology has specifically authorized such use at such  
9 lower standard."

10 On page 4, beginning on line 17 of the amendment, after "class A"  
11 strike "reclaimed water standard" and insert "or B reclaimed water  
12 standards"

13 On page 4, beginning on line 22 of the amendment, after "class A"  
14 strike "reclaimed water standard" and insert "or B reclaimed water  
15 standards"

16 On page 4, beginning on line 25 of the amendment, after "lower"  
17 strike all material through "treatment" on line 27, and insert  
18 "standards"

19 EFFECT: Allows reclaimed water of a lower standard to be applied  
20 to the ground surface if the Department of Ecology authorizes such use.  
21 Allows Class B reclaimed water to be discharged into created wetlands.  
22 Strikes language regarding a pilot project.

26 On page 12, beginning on line 6 of the amendment, strike all of  
27 section 17

28 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct the title  
29 accordingly.

1        EFFECT:    Strikes the section which appropriates \$100,000 to the  
2 Department of Health from Referendum 38 bond funds.
