5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.360 and 1995 c 116 s 7 are each amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 (1) Each person who returns a steelhead catch record card to an  
10 authorized license dealer within thirty days following the period for  
11 which it was issued shall be given a credit equal to five dollars  
12 towards that day's purchase of any license, permit, transport tag, or  
13 stamp required by this chapter. This subsection does not apply to  
14 annual steelhead catch record cards for persons under the age of  
15 fifteen.

16 (2) Each person who returns a steelhead catch record card to the  
17 department within thirty days following the period for which it was  
18 issued shall be issued a nontransferable credit equal to five dollars  
19 towards the purchase of the next year's steelhead fishing license.  
20 Lost, stolen, or destroyed credits will not be replaced. This  
21 subsection does not apply to annual steelhead catch record cards for  
22 persons under the age of fifteen.

23 (3) Catch record cards necessary for proper management of the  
24 state's game fish resources shall be administered under rules adopted  
25 by the director and issued at no charge.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW  
27 to read as follows:

28 (1) Each person who returns a 1995 steelhead fishing license to the  
29 department shall be issued a nontransferable credit equal to six  
30 dollars towards a 1997 steelhead fishing license. A person who  
31 purchased a 1995 steelhead fishing license but is no longer in  
32 possession of the license may apply to the department for a six-dollar  
33 credit by completing a written affidavit provided by the department.

34 (2) Each person who returns a 1995 juvenile steelhead fishing  
35 license to the department shall be issued a nontransferable credit

1 equal to two dollars towards the appropriate 1997 steelhead fishing  
2 license. A person who purchased a 1995 juvenile steelhead fishing  
3 license but is no longer in possession of the license may apply to the  
4 department for a two-dollar credit by completing a written affidavit  
5 provided by the department.

6 (3) A person who purchased a 1995 steelhead fishing license or a  
7 1995 juvenile steelhead fishing license is eligible for no more than  
8 one credit issued under this section.

9 (4) This section expires December 31, 1997."
