7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28B.15.558 and 1992 c 231 s 20 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 (1) The governing boards of the state universities, the regional
10 universities, The Evergreen State College, and the community colleges
11 may waive all or a portion of the tuition and services and activities
12 fees for state employees as defined under subsection (2) of this
13 section pursuant to the following conditions:

14 (a) Such state employees shall register for and be enrolled in
15 courses on a space available basis and no new course sections shall be
16 created as a result of the registration;

17 (b) Enrollment information on state employees registered pursuant
18 to this section shall be maintained separately from other enrollment
19 information and shall not be included in official enrollment reports,
20 nor shall such state employees be considered in any enrollment
21 statistics which would affect budgetary determinations; and

22 (c) State employees registering on a space available basis shall be
23 charged a registration fee of not less than five dollars.

24 (2) For the purposes of this section, "state employees" means
25 permanent ((full-time)) employees employed half-time or more in
26 classified service under chapter((s 28B.16 and)) 41.06 RCW; permanent
27 employees employed half-time or more who are governed by chapter 41.56
28 RCW pursuant to the exercise of the option under RCW 41.56.201;
29 permanent classified employees and exempt paraprofessional employees of
30 technical colleges employed half-time or more; and nonacademic
31 employees and members of the faculties and instructional staff employed
32 half-time or more at institutions of higher education as defined in RCW
33 28B.10.016.

34 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
35 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

1 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
2 effect immediately."
