- 16 nonstate agency professional archaeologists and volunteer citizens. It

- 23 military fort located in the Puget Sound area. To the extent possible,
- 24 the study shall be designed and implemented using nonstate agency
- 25 personnel and shall include a professional archaeologist and volunteer
- 26 citizens.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The sum of eighteen thousand dollars, or as
- 28 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium
- 29 ending June 30, 1997, from the general fund to the parks and recreation
- 30 commission for the purposes of section 2 of this act."
