7 On page 9, after line 17 of the committee amendment, insert the
8 following:

9 "Sec. 11. RCW 36.18.010 and 1991 c 26 s 2 are each amended to read
10 as follows:

11 County auditors or recording officers shall collect the following
12 fees for their official services:

13 For recording instruments, for the first page, legal size (eight
14 and one-half by fourteen inches or less), five dollars; for each
15 additional legal size page, one dollar; the fee for recording multiple
16 transactions contained in one instrument will be calculated
17 individually for each transaction requiring separate indexing as
18 required under RCW 65.04.050;

19 For preparing and certifying copies, for the first legal size page,
20 three dollars; for each additional legal size page, one dollar;

21 For preparing noncertified copies, for each legal size page, one
22 dollar;

23 For administering an oath or taking an affidavit, with or without
24 seal, two dollars;

25 For issuing a marriage license, eight dollars, (this fee includes
26 taking necessary affidavits, filing returns, indexing, and transmittal
27 of a record of the marriage to the state registrar of vital statistics)
28 plus an additional five-dollar fee for use and support of the
29 prevention of child abuse and neglect activities to be transmitted
30 monthly to the state treasurer and deposited in the state general fund,
31 (~~which five dollar fee shall expire June 30, 1995,~~) plus an
32 additional ten-dollar fee to be transmitted monthly to the state
33 treasurer and deposited in the state general fund. The legislature
34 intends to appropriate an amount at least equal to the revenue
35 generated by this fee for the purposes of the displaced homemaker act,
36 chapter 28B.04 RCW;

37 For searching records per hour, eight dollars;

1 For recording plats, fifty cents for each lot except cemetery plats
2 for which the charge shall be twenty-five cents per lot; also one
3 dollar for each acknowledgment, dedication, and description: PROVIDED,
4 That there shall be a minimum fee of twenty-five dollars per plat;

5 For recording of miscellaneous records, not listed above, for first
6 legal size page, five dollars; for each additional legal size page, one
7 dollar;

8 For modernization and improvement of the recording and indexing
9 system, a surcharge as provided in RCW 36.22.170."

10 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
11 internal references accordingly.
