- 5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 6 following:
- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that existing general 8 aviation airports are essential to the state's interest in an efficient 9 and effective transportation system. Consequently, such airports, 10 whether publicly owned or privately owned public-use, should be 11 protected against future encroachment by incompatible land uses.
- 12 It is the purpose of this act to protect existing general aviation airports against encroachment by incompatible land uses. It is also 13 the purpose of this act to protect public health, safety, and welfare 14 15 by encouraging adoption of land use measures that minimize the public's 16 exposure to excessive noise and safety hazards within areas around public general aviation airports and private public-use general 17 aviation airports to the extent that these areas are not already 18 devoted to incompatible uses. 19
- 20 **Sec. 2.** RCW 47.06.030 and 1993 c 446 s 3 are each amended to read 21 as follows:
- 22 The commission shall develop a state transportation policy plan 23 that (1) establishes a vision and goals for the development of the 24 state-wide transportation system consistent with the state's growth 25 management goals, (2) identifies significant state-wide transportation policy issues, among which shall be assuring the preservation of the 26 general aviation airport system including all public-use airports, and 27 (3) recommends state-wide transportation policies and strategies to the 28 29 legislature to fulfill the requirements of RCW 47.01.071(1). The state transportation policy plan shall be the product of an ongoing process 30 31 that involves representatives of significant transportation interests and the general public from across the state. 32
- 33 **Sec. 3.** RCW 47.06.060 and 1993 c 446 s 6 are each amended to read as follows:

- of the state-wide multimodal 1 The state-interest component 2 transportation plan shall include an aviation plan, which shall ensure 3 that public-use and state general aviation airports remain a viable 4 state-wide transportation network and are, to the greatest extent possible, protected against encroachment by incompatible land uses, 5 fulfill the state-wide aviation planning requirements of the federal 6 7 government, coordinate state-wide aviation planning, and identify the 8 program needs for public use and state airports.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 47.06 RCW 10 to read as follows:
- By December 1, 1996, the aviation division of the department of transportation shall develop and distribute model comprehensive plans and development regulations that implement sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act. The model plans and regulations must be developed in consultation with cities, towns, counties, airport owners and managers, private airport operators, general aviation pilots, and ports.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 36.70 RCW to read as follows:
- Following the development and distribution of model comprehensive 19 plans and development regulations under section 4 of this act, every 20 county, city, and town in which there is located a general aviation 21 22 airport that is operated for the benefit of the general public, whether 23 publicly owned or privately owned public use, shall, through its 24 comprehensive plan and development regulations, discourage the siting 25 of incompatible uses adjacent to such general aviation airport. Such plans and regulations may only be adopted or amended after formal 26 27 Airport owners and managers, private airport consultation with: 28 operators, general aviation pilots, ports, and the aviation division of 29 the department of transportation. All proposed and adopted plans and regulations shall be filed with the aviation division of the department 30 of transportation within a reasonable time after release for public 31 32 consideration and comment. Each county, city, and town may obtain 33 technical assistance from the aviation division of the department of transportation to develop plans and regulations consistent with this 34 35 section.

- 3 course of land-use proceedings.
- 4 This section applies to every county, city, and town, whether
- 5 operating under chapter 35.63, 35A.63, 36.70, 36.70A RCW, or under a

- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 35.63 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
