- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.94 RCW 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (1) A gasoline vapor recovery device that captures vapors during 10 vehicle fueling may only be required at a service station, or any other 11 gasoline dispensing facility supplying fuel to the general public, in 12 any of the following circumstances:
- (a) The facility sells in excess of six hundred thousand gallons of gasoline per year and is located in a county, any part of which is designated as nonattainment for ozone under the federal clean air act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 7407; or
- (b) The facility sells in excess of six hundred thousand gallons of gasoline per year and is located in a county where a maintenance plan has been adopted by a local air pollution control authority or the department of ecology that includes gasoline vapor recovery devices as a control strategy; or
- (c) From the effective date of this section until December 31, 22 1998, in any facility that sells in excess of one million two hundred 23 thousand gallons of gasoline per year and is located in an ozone-24 25 contributing county. For purposes of this section, an ozonecontributing county means a county in which the emissions have 26 27 contributed to the formation of ozone in any county where violations of federal ozone standards have been measured, and includes: 28 Cowlitz, 29 Island, Kitsap, Lewis, Skagit, Thurston, Wahkiakum, and Whatcom 30 counties; or
- 31 (d) After December 31, 1998, in any facility that sells in excess 32 of eight hundred forty thousand gallons of gasoline per year and is 33 located in any county, no part of which is designated as nonattainment 34 for ozone under the federal clean air act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 7407, 35 provided that the department of ecology determines by December 31, 36 1997, that the use of gasoline vapor control devices in the county is

- 1 important to achieving or maintaining attainment status in any other 2 county.
- 3 (2) This section does not preclude the department of ecology or any 4 local air pollution authority from requiring a gasoline vapor recovery 5 device that captures vapors during vehicle refueling as part of the 6 regulation of sources as provided in RCW 70.94.152, 70.94.331, or 70.94.141 or where required under 42 U.S.C. Sec. 7412.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate 9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take 11 effect immediately."
