- 11 (2) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's 12 institutions of higher education for the 1995-96 academic year, other 13 than the summer term, shall be as provided in this subsection.
- 14 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State 15 University:
- (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, two thousand seven hundred sixty-four dollars;
- 20 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident 21 students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading 22 to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and 23 doctor of veterinary medicine, eight thousand two hundred sixty-eight 24 dollars;
- (iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand four hundred ninety dollars;
- (iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, eleven thousand six hundred thirty-four dollars;
- (v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, seven thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars; and

- 1 (vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the 2 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of 3 veterinary medicine, nineteen thousand four hundred thirty-one dollars.
 - (b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College:
- 5 (i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not 6 in graduate study programs, two thousand forty-five dollars;
- 7 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident 8 students not in graduate study programs, seven thousand nine hundred 9 ninety-two dollars;
- 10 (iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand four hundred 11 forty-three dollars; and
- 12 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand seventy-one dollars.
- 14 (c) At the community colleges:

- 15 (i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred twelve dollars; 16 and
- 17 (ii) For nonresident students, five thousand one hundred sixty-two dollars and fifty cents.
- 19 (3) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's 20 institutions of higher education beginning with the 1996-97 academic 21 year, other than the summer term, shall be as provided in this 22 subsection.
- 23 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State 24 University:
- (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, two thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars;
- (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, ((eight thousand five hundred ninety- nine)) nine thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars;
- (iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand six hundred sixty-nine dollars;
- (iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental

- surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, twelve thousand one hundred
 dollars;
- (v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, seven thousand seven hundred ninety-seven dollars; and
- 7 (vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the 8 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of 9 veterinary medicine, twenty thousand two hundred nine dollars. 10 However, for students under (a)(ii) of this subsection who were 11 enrolled before January 1, 1996, and continue to be enrolled without a
- break in attendance, the tuition shall be eight thousand five hundred
 ninety-nine dollars.
- 14 (b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College:
- (i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not in graduate study programs, two thousand one hundred twenty-seven dollars;
- 18 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident 19 students not in graduate study programs, eight thousand three hundred 20 twelve dollars;
- 21 (iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand five hundred 22 eighty-one dollars; and
- 23 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand five 24 hundred fourteen dollars.
- 25 (c) At the community colleges:
- 26 (i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred sixty-one 27 dollars; and
- (ii) For nonresident students, five thousand three hundred sixtynine dollars and fifty cents.
- 30 (4) The tuition fees established under this chapter shall not apply 31 to high school students enrolling in community colleges under RCW 32 28A.600.300 through 28A.600.395.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 37 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act expires July 1, 1997."
