7 "Sec. 1. RCW 9.46.110 and 1994 c 301 s 2 are each amended to read 8 as follows:

9 The legislative authority of any county, city-county, city, or 10 town, by local law and ordinance, and in accordance with the provisions of this chapter and rules and regulations promulgated hereunder, may 11 12 provide for the taxing of any gambling activity authorized by this 13 chapter within its jurisdiction, the tax receipts to go to the county, 14 city-county, city, or town so taxing the same: PROVIDED, That any such 15 tax imposed by a county alone shall not apply to any gambling activity 16 within a city or town located therein but the tax rate established by a county, if any, shall constitute the tax rate throughout the 17 unincorporated areas of such county: PROVIDED FURTHER, That (1) punch 18 19 boards and pull-tabs, chances on which shall only be sold to adults, 20 which shall have a ((fifty cent)) one dollar limit on a single chance thereon, shall be taxed on a basis which shall reflect only the gross 21 receipts from such punch boards and pull-tabs; and (2) no punch board 22 or pull-tab may award as a prize upon a winning number or symbol being 23 24 drawn the opportunity of taking a chance upon any other punch board or 25 pull-tab; and (3) all prizes for punch boards and pull-tabs must be on display within the immediate area of the premises wherein any such 26 27 punch board or pull-tab is located and upon a winning number or symbol being drawn, such prize must be immediately removed therefrom, or such 28 omission shall be deemed a fraud for the purposes of this chapter; and 29 30 (4) when any person shall win over twenty dollars in money or merchandise from any punch board or pull-tab, every licensee hereunder 31 shall keep a public record thereof for at least ninety days thereafter 32 containing such information as the commission shall deem necessary: 33 34 AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That taxation of bingo and raffles shall never be 35 in an amount greater than ten percent of the gross revenue received 36 therefrom less the amount paid for or as prizes. Taxation of amusement

games shall only be in an amount sufficient to pay the actual costs of 1 2 enforcement of the provisions of this chapter by the county, city or town law enforcement agency and in no event shall such taxation exceed 3 two percent of the gross revenue therefrom less the amount paid for as 4 PROVIDED FURTHER, That no tax shall be imposed under the 5 authority of this chapter on bingo or amusement games when such 6 activities or any combination thereof are conducted by any bona fide 7 8 charitable or nonprofit organization as defined in this chapter, which 9 organization has no paid operating or management personnel and has 10 gross income from bingo or amusement games, or a combination thereof, 11 not exceeding five thousand dollars per year, less the amount paid for 12 as prizes. No tax shall be imposed on the first ten thousand dollars 13 of net proceeds from raffles conducted by any bona fide charitable or nonprofit organization as defined in this chapter. Taxation of punch 14 15 boards and pull-tabs shall ((not exceed five percent of gross receipts)) be at the option of the local taxing authority and may be 16 17 levied either: (a) On gross receipts at a rate not to exceed five percent; or (b) on gross receipts less the amount paid out as prizes, 18 19 at a rate not to exceed ten percent, nor shall taxation of social card 20 games exceed ((twenty)) ten percent of the gross revenue from such games <u>less the amount paid for as prizes</u>. 21

Taxes imposed under this chapter become a lien upon personal and real property used in the gambling activity in the same manner as provided for under RCW 84.60.010. The lien shall attach on the date the tax becomes due and shall relate back and have priority against real and personal property to the same extent as ad valorem taxes."
