- 5 On page 1, after line 8, strike the remainder of the joint memorial 6 and insert the following:
- 7 "WHEREAS, The federal government, in an effort to protect the
- 8 national security of the United States, established the Hanford site in
- 9 Central Washington in 1943; and
- 10 WHEREAS, During the course of the past five decades, many
- 11 dangerous, toxic, and nuclear wastes were disposed of or stored at the
- 12 site; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Two-thirds of the volume of nuclear waste in the entire
- 14 United States is stored at Hanford; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Department of Energy has been tasked with overseeing
- 16 the cleanup of the site; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Millions of dollars have been expended at Hanford for
- 18 environmental cleanup; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The United States General Accounting Office estimates that
- 20 a significant amount of the cleanup funds have been expended on
- 21 administrative and legal activities; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The federal government agreed under the "Tri-Party
- 23 Agreement" to a series of milestones to clean up the site; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Key milestones in this agreement cannot be met if the
- 25 Department of Energy follows through on its proposal to reduce cleanup
- 26 funding at the Hanford site; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The federal government has now announced that four
- 28 thousand five hundred jobs will be eliminated as a result of these
- 29 cuts; and
- 30 WHEREAS, These cuts will delay the cleanup and increase its cost.
- 31 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 32 federal government work with Washington State and local officials to
- 33 eliminate duplicative Department of Energy orders, streamline paperwork
- 34 requirements, and otherwise reduce unnecessary costs so that full and
- 35 adequate funding may be available for environmental cleanup; that it
- 36 begin immediately to construct the facilities necessary to implement
- 37 cleanup of the Hanford site; and that it maintain its commitment to

- 1 funding and implementing all the key milestones of the "Tri-Party 2 Agreement."
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 4 transmitted to the Honorable Bill Clinton, President of the United
- 5 States, the Secretary of the Department of Energy, the President of the
- 6 United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and
- 7 each member of Congress from the State of Washington."
