## 6 "PART VI - FURNISHING LIQUOR TO MINORS

- 7 **Sec. 32.** RCW 66.44.270 and 1993 c 513 s 1 are each amended to read 8 as follows:
- 9 (1)(a) It is unlawful for any person to sell, give, or otherwise 10 supply liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one years or permit 11 any person under that age to consume liquor on his or her premises or 12 on any premises under his or her control. For the purposes of this 13 subsection, "premises" includes real property, houses, buildings, and 14 other structures, and motor vehicles and watercraft.
- 15 (b) Violation of this subsection is a gross misdemeanor.
- 16 (2)(a) It is unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one 17 years to possess, consume, or otherwise acquire any liquor.
- 18 (b) It is unlawful for a person under the age of twenty-one years 19 to be in a public place, or to be in a motor vehicle in a public place, while exhibiting the effects of having consumed liquor. For purposes 20 21 of this subsection, exhibiting the effects of having consumed liquor 22 means that a person has the odor of liquor on his or her breath and 23 either: (i) Is in possession of or close proximity to a container that has or recently had liquor in it; or (ii) by speech, manner, 24 appearance, behavior, lack of coordination, or otherwise, exhibits that 25 26 he or she is under the influence of liquor. This subsection (2)(b) does not apply if the person is in the presence of a parent or quardian 27 28 or has consumed or is consuming liquor under circumstances described in subsection (4) or (5) of this section. 29
- 30 (3) Subsections (1) and (2)(a) of this section do not apply to 31 liquor given or permitted to be given to a person under the age of 32 twenty-one years by a parent or guardian and consumed in the presence 33 of the parent or guardian. This subsection shall not authorize 34 consumption or possession of liquor by a person under the age of 35 twenty-one years on any premises licensed under chapter 66.24 RCW.

- 1 (4) This section does not apply to liquor given for medicinal 2 purposes to a person under the age of twenty-one years by a parent, 3 guardian, physician, or dentist.
- 4 (5) This section does not apply to liquor given to a person under 5 the age of twenty-one years when such liquor is being used in 6 connection with religious services and the amount consumed is the 7 minimal amount necessary for the religious service.
- 8 (6) Conviction or forfeiture of bail for a violation of this 9 section by a person under the age of twenty-one years at the time of 10 such conviction or forfeiture shall not be a disqualification of that 11 person to acquire a license to sell or dispense any liquor after that 12 person has attained the age of twenty-one years."
