5 On page 33, after line 9, insert the following:

6 "(4) The director shall establish an advisory committee to develop
7 new and review existing technical provisions for hydraulic project
8 permit conditions that would commonly apply to bulkhead construction.
9 The purpose of the advisory committee shall be to develop
10 recommendations for legislative and rule changes that (1) protect
11 against the loss of property of waterfront shoreline owners; (2)
12 facilitate the timely issuance of hydraulic permits and the prompt
13 completion of projects; (3) reduce subjective project approval
14 decisions by the department; and (4) foster better working
15 relationships between bulkhead contractors, landowners, and the
16 department. These recommendations shall be based on scientific
17 evidence that demonstrates the association of project activities with
18 impacts on fish life. The advisory committee shall be comprised of
19 technical experts in the field of bulkhead construction, civil
20 engineering, hydrology, and fish biology. By January 1, 1996 the
21 committee shall submit recommendations to the director and the natural
22 resources committees of the House and Senate. The advisory committee
23 shall expire on December 31, 1996."
