25 violations under the following conditions:

26 (a) An automated traffic enforcement system must be operated by a
27 law enforcement agency in a law enforcement vehicle plainly marked with
28 emergency lights and the agency shield or emblem on the exterior of the
29 vehicle; and

30 (b) The local law enforcement agency shall plainly mark the
31 locations where the automated traffic enforcement system is used by
32 placing signs on street locations that clearly indicate to a driver
33 that he or she is entering a zone enforced by an automated traffic

1 enforcement system.
