5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 43.62.035 and 1991 sp.s. c 32 s 30 are each amended
8 to read as follows:

9 The office of financial management shall determine the population
10 of each county of the state annually as of April 1st of each year and
11 on or before July 1st of each year shall file a certificate with the
12 secretary of state showing its determination of the population for each
13 county. The office of financial management also shall determine the
14 percentage increase in population for each county over the preceding
15 ten-year period, as of April 1st, and shall file a certificate with the
16 secretary of state by July 1st showing its determination. At least
17 once every ten years the office of financial management shall prepare
18 twenty-year growth management planning population projections required
19 by RCW 36.70A.110 for each county that adopts a comprehensive plan
20 under RCW 36.70A.040 and shall review these projections with such
21 counties and the cities in those counties before final adoption. Each
22 projection shall be expressed as a reasonable range developed within
23 the standard state high and low projection. The middle range shall
24 represent the office's estimate of the most likely population
25 projection for the county. If any city or county believes that a
26 projection will not accurately reflect actual population growth in a
27 county, it may petition the office to revise the projection
28 accordingly. The office shall complete the first set of ranges for
29 every county by December 31, 1995.

30 A comprehensive plan adopted or amended between April 1, 1995, and
31 December 31, 1995, shall not be considered to be in noncompliance with
32 the twenty-year growth management planning population projection if the
33 projection used in the comprehensive plan is in compliance with the
34 range later adopted under this section.

35 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate

1 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
2 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
3 effect immediately."
