The district court may, in its discretion, 29 increase the award of damages to an amount not more than three times the actual damages sustained, but such increased damage award shall not 30 31 exceed the amount specified in RCW 3.66.020. For the purpose of this section "person" shall include the counties, municipalities, and all 32 political subdivisions of this state. 33

Whenever the state of Washington is injured by reason of a violation of RCW 19.86.030, 19.86.040, 19.86.050, or 19.86.060, it may sue therefor in the superior court to recover the actual damages sustained by it and to recover the costs of the suit including a reasonable attorney's fee."
