The senate members of the committee shall be appointed by the president of 11 12 the senate, and the house members of the committee shall be appointed by the speaker of the house. Not more than two members from each house 13 14 may be from the same political party. The appointing authorities shall 15 also appoint one alternate member from each caucus of each house. All 16 appointments to the committee are subject to approval by the caucuses 17 to which the appointed members belong.
- (2) Members <u>and alternates</u> shall be appointed as soon as possible after the legislature convenes in regular session in an odd-numbered year, and their terms shall extend until their successors are appointed and qualified at the next regular session of the legislature in an odd-numbered year or until such ((members)) <u>persons</u> no longer serve in the legislature, whichever occurs first. Members <u>and alternates</u> may be reappointed to ((a)) <u>the</u> committee.
  - (3) The president of the senate shall appoint the chairperson in even-numbered years and the vice chairperson in odd-numbered years from among committee membership. The speaker of the house shall appoint the chairperson in odd-numbered years and the vice chairperson in even-numbered years from among committee membership. Such appointments shall be made in January of each year as soon as possible after a legislative session convenes.
- 32 (4) The chairperson of the committee shall cause all meeting
  33 notices and committee documents to be sent to the members and
  34 alternates. A vacancy ((on the committee)) shall be filled by
  35 appointment of a legislator from the same political party as the
