1 AN ACT Relating to public utility districts bid procedures; and
2 amending RCW 54.04.082.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 54.04.082 and 1993 c 198 s 15 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 For the awarding of a contract to purchase any item, or items of
7 the same kind of materials, equipment, or supplies in an amount
8 exceeding five thousand dollars, but less than (~~fifteen~~) thirty-five
9 thousand dollars, exclusive of sales tax, the commission may, in lieu
10 of the procedure described in RCW 54.04.070 and 54.04.080 requiring
11 public notice to invite sealed proposals for such materials, equipment,
12 or supplies, pursuant to commission resolution use the process provided
13 in RCW 39.04.190. Waiver of the deposit or bid bond required under RCW
14 54.04.080 may be authorized by the commission in securing such bid
15 quotations.
