10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 11 to read as follows:

12 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of 13 academic transcripts by educational institutions.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 15 to read as follows:

16 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the 17 use of academic transcripts.
