- 1 AN ACT Relating to payment of benefits when a member dies before
- 2 retirement; amending RCW 41.40.270; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) If a member dies following a period of
- 5 sick leave without having applied for a disability retirement under RCW
- 6 41.32.550, the member's surviving spouse is eligible to receive, from
- 7 the time of the member's death, a joint and one hundred percent
- 8 retirement allowance under RCW 41.32.530, without the actuarial
- 9 reduction otherwise required by RCW 41.32.520 (1)(b)(ii), if the
- 10 following conditions are met:
- 11 (a) The member had been on sick leave due to an illness that would
- 12 have qualified the member for permanent disability under RCW 41.32.550;
- 13 and
- 14 (b) The illness was the cause of the member's death.
- 15 (2) This section applies to members who died between July 1, 1994,
- 16 and September 1, 1994.
- 17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.40.270 and 1995 c 144 s 5 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

- 1 (1) Should a member die before the date of retirement the amount of 2 the accumulated contributions standing to the member's credit in the 3 employees' savings fund, less any amount identified as owing to an 4 obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a 5 court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, at the time of death:
 - (a) Shall be paid to the member's estate, or such person or persons, trust, or organization as the member shall have nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the department; or
- 9 (b) If there be no such designated person or persons still living 10 at the time of the member's death, or if a member fails to file a new 11 beneficiary designation subsequent to marriage, remarriage, dissolution of marriage, divorce, or reestablishment of membership following 12 13 termination by withdrawal or retirement, such accumulated contributions, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon 14 withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed 15 16 under RCW 41.50.670, shall be paid to the surviving spouse as if in 17 fact such spouse had been nominated by written designation as aforesaid, or if there be no such surviving spouse, then to the 18 19 member's legal representatives.
- (2) Upon the death in service, or while on authorized leave of 20 absence for a period not to exceed one hundred and twenty days from the 21 date of payroll separation, of any member who is qualified but has not 22 applied for a service retirement allowance or has completed ten years 23 24 of service at the time of death, the designated beneficiary, or the 25 surviving spouse as provided in subsection (1) of this section, may 26 elect to waive the payment provided by subsection (1) of this section. 27 Upon such an election, a joint and one hundred percent survivor option under RCW 41.40.188, calculated under the retirement allowance 28 29 described in RCW 41.40.185 or 41.40.190, whichever is greater, 30 actuarially reduced by the amount of any lump sum benefit identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions 31 pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670 shall automatically 32 be given effect as if selected for the benefit of the designated 33 34 beneficiary. If the member is not then qualified for a service 35 retirement allowance, such benefit shall be based upon the actuarial equivalent of the sum necessary to pay the accrued regular retirement 36 37 allowance commencing when the deceased member would have first qualified for a service retirement allowance. 38

- (3) Subsection (1) of this section, unless elected, shall not apply 1 to any member who has applied for service retirement in RCW 41.40.180, 2 as now or hereafter amended, and thereafter dies between the date of 3 4 separation from service and the member's effective retirement date, where the member has selected a survivorship option under RCW 5 41.40.188. In those cases the beneficiary named in the member's final 6 7 application for service retirement may elect to receive either a cash 8 refund, less any amount identified as owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed 9 under RCW 41.50.670, or monthly payments according to the option 10 selected by the member. 11
- (4) For deaths occurring between July 1, 1995, and June 30, 1997, 12 if a member who: (a) Has applied for nonduty disability under RCW 13 41.40.230; (b) has submitted adequate evidence to support a disability 14 15 determination; and (c) has selected a retirement under RCW 41.40.188, dies before receiving the first retirement payment, the beneficiary 16 named in the member's final application for disability retirement may 17 elect to receive either a cash refund, less any amount identified as 18 19 owing to an obligee upon withdrawal of accumulated contributions pursuant to a court order filed under RCW 41.50.670, or monthly 20 payments according to the option selected by the member. 21
