- 1 AN ACT Relating to mental health services; and adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 48.43 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) For purposes of this section:
- 7 (a) "Health carrier" includes disability insurers regulated under
- 8 chapter 48.20 or 48.21 RCW, health care services contractors regulated
- 9 under chapter 48.44 RCW, plans operating under the health care
- 10 authority under chapter 41.05 RCW, the basic health plan operating
- 11 under chapter 70.47 RCW, the state health insurance pool operating
- 12 under chapter 48.41 RCW, insuring entities regulated under this
- 13 chapter, and health maintenance organizations regulated under chapter
- 14 48.46 RCW.
- 15 (b) "Intermediary" means a person duly authorized to negotiate and
- 16 execute provider contracts with health carriers on behalf of mental
- 17 health care practitioners.
- 18 (c) Consistent with their lawful scopes of practice, "mental health
- 19 care practitioners" includes only the following: Any generally

- 1 recognized medical specialty of practitioners licensed under chapter
- 2 18.57 or 18.71 RCW who provide mental health services, advanced
- 3 practice psychiatric nurses as authorized by the nursing care quality
- 4 assurance commission under chapter 18.79 RCW, psychologists licensed
- 5 under chapter 18.83 RCW, social workers, marriage and family
- 6 therapists, and mental health counselors certified under chapter 18.19
- 7 RCW.
- 8 (d) "Mental health services" means outpatient services.
- 9 (2) Consistent with federal and state law and rule, no contract
- 10 between a mental health care practitioner and an intermediary or
- 11 between a mental health care practitioner and a health carrier that is
- 12 written, amended, or renewed after the effective date of this section
- 13 may contain a provision prohibiting a practitioner and an enrollee from
- 14 agreeing to contract for services solely at the expense of the enrollee
- 15 as follows:
- 16 (a) On the exhaustion of the enrollee's mental health care
- 17 coverage;
- 18 (b) During an appeal or an adverse certification process;
- 19 (c) When an enrollee's condition is excluded from coverage; or
- 20 (d) For any other clinically appropriate reason at any time.
- 21 (3) If a mental health care practitioner provides services to an
- 22 enrollee during an appeal or adverse certification process, the
- 23 practitioner must provide to the enrollee written notification that the
- 24 enrollee is responsible for payment of these services, unless the
- 25 health carrier elects to pay for services provided.
- 26 (4) This section does not apply to a mental health care
- 27 practitioner who is employed full time on the staff of a health
- 28 carrier.
