- 1 AN ACT Relating to internship credit for teachers; amending RCW
- 2 28A.415.020; adding a new section to chapter 28A.415 RCW; and creating

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that if students are
- 6 to succeed in an increasingly competitive economy, they will need to be
- 7 taught by teachers who are aware of the technological innovations and
- 8 changes that are occurring throughout business, industry, and
- 9 government. Having teachers who are more aware of these changes will
- 10 lead to improvements in curriculum and instruction, thereby making
- 11 public schools more relevant to the future career and personal needs of
- 12 our students.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28A.415.020 and 1990 c 33 s 415 are each amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (1) Certificated personnel shall receive for each ten clock hours
- 16 of approved in-service training attended the equivalent of a one credit
- 17 college quarter course on the salary schedule developed by the
- 18 legislative evaluation and accountability program committee.

- 1 (2) Certificated personnel shall receive for each ten clock hours 2 of approved continuing education earned, as continuing education is 3 defined by rule adopted by the state board of education, the equivalent 4 of a one credit college quarter course on the salary schedule developed 5 by the legislative evaluation and accountability program committee.
 - (3) Certificated personnel shall receive for each forty clock hours of participation in an approved internship with a business, an industry, or government, as an internship is defined by rule of the state board of education in accordance with section 3 of this act, the equivalent of a one credit college quarter course on the salary schedule developed by the legislative evaluation and accountability program committee.
 - (4) An approved in-service training program shall be a program approved by a school district board of directors, which meet standards adopted by the state board of education, and the development of said program has been participated in by an in-service training task force whose membership is the same as provided under RCW 28A.415.040, or a program offered by an education agency approved to provide in-service for the purposes of continuing education as provided for under rules adopted by the state board of education, or both.
- ((\(\frac{4+}{1}\))) (5) Clock hours eligible for application to the salary schedule developed by the legislative evaluation and accountability program committee as described in subsections (1) and (2) of this section, shall be those hours acquired after August 31, 1987. Clock hours eligible for application to the salary schedule as described in subsection (3) of this section shall be those hours acquired after December 31, 1995.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.415 RCW to read as follows:
- The state board of education shall establish rules for awarding 30 clock hours for participation of certificated personnel in internships 31 with business, industry, or government. To receive clock hours for an 32 33 internship, the individual must demonstrate that the internship will 34 provide beneficial skills and knowledge in an area directly related to his or her current assignment, or to his or her assignment for the 35 36 following school year. An individual may not receive more than the 37 equivalent of two college quarter credits for internships during a 38 calendar-year period. The total number of credits for internships that

NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The legislative office on performance audit and fiscal analysis shall conduct an evaluation, by December 15, 1997, of internship credits granted to teachers to advance on the salary schedule as provided in section 2 of this act. This evaluation shall compare the efficacy of internship, in-service, and academic credits as recognized in the state salary allocation schedule in the omnibus appropriations act, in improving teacher effectiveness and
